Topic/Speaker: **Evolution of Drilled Shaft Construction and Techniques in the Northeast**

Mr Roma will discuss the evolution of drilled shaft construction and techniques in the Northeast. The presentation will cover the early testing of both soil and rock to establish design values in friction and end-bearing shafts, and also to test the validity of the installation procedure itself. Shafts installed "in-the-dry" will be discussed, as well as those installed under slurry. Trends of shafts with greater diameters and ever-deepening rock sockets will be discussed, as well as the evolution of the equipment to install the shafts. Projects from the Big Dig will be presented, as well as other interesting and challenging projects throughout the Northeast.
