**Precast Concrete Beam Production
and Static Load Test**

PROGRAM:

This program will describe the processes and materials used in the design and production of engineered precast concrete beam products. The program will consist of a sit-down presentation, a tour of Oldcastle Precast's manufacturing facility, and a static load test of a concrete beam. The sit-down portion will include a presentation of design, detailing, construction fabrication, and erection. During the plant tour, the emphasis will be on demonstrating actual production techniques and details. The load test demonstration will compare theoretical and actual behavior of a precast concrete beam.

PRESENTER:

Directions to Oldcastle Precast (South Bethlehem, NY Plant)

Exit NYS Thruway (I-87) at Exit 22
After the toll booth, take a right to go south on **RT 144**.
Go about 100 yards and take a right to go west on **RT 396**.
Continue straight over bridge over the thruway and another 2 miles.
Continue straight on **RT 396** through RT 9W intersection (traffic light).
Continue straight on **RT 396** for another 2 miles and take a left on **RT 101**.
(about ¼ mile after you pass the Firehouse on left side)
(The RT101 dark blue sign is on the right side at eye level)
(RT 101 is a T-intersection, you cannot turn right)

On RT 101, go carefully down and back up a hill (less than ¼ mile).
Continue straight past blinking yellow light, then large truck ramp on right.
Immediately after, there will be a 3 story office building on the left.
Take a left into the parking lot just after the office building.

This is actually the Oldcastle Corporate office where we will have our breakfast meeting and presentation first.

The plant is on the other side of the road up on the hill.
