

# **ASCE MOHAWK-HUDSON SECTION TRANSPORTATION GROUP FIELD TRIP**

**The Transportation Group invites all Section Members, and others who may be interested in joining the Group on a tour of the Slingerlands Bypass Project (Route 85) in Albany, NY on Thursday September 27<sup>th</sup>, 2007. The project will be approximately 50% complete at the time of the tour and is expected to be completed in summer of 2008. The project includes the construction of:**

- **4,200 feet of new 4-lane divided highway**
- **Four roundabouts**
- **Several detention basins**
- **Wetland mitigation areas**
- **A new structure over the Normans Kill, and a pre-fab pedestrian structure over the Krum Kill.**

**We will meet in the parking lot of Price Chopper at 10:00 AM and begin the project tour from there. It is expected that the tour will last about 1 ½ hours and will be followed by lunch at the New York Style Deli in Price Chopper.**
